MISSION OF THE KING

Petition: To Abolish the cutting of the locks of Rastafarian's within the Commonwealth of the Bahamas

TO: Rt. Hon. Hubert Ingraham, Prime Minister Commonwealth of the Bahamas.

We, the Undersigned Individuals, hereby state:

THAT in recent years here in the **Commonwealth of the Bahamas** there has been a number of discrimination matters of concern, afforded by government's agents against the Rastafari community. Besides the shootings, killings and Rastafari profiling, harassments and Police brutality which are all horrific, tragic, degrading and inhumane. However there's one case that stands out or shall we say, is time to spot light and that is; the locks cutting situation.

THAT after careful objective and analytic observation, we have concluded that this matter is a very serious one of international interest because cutting ones locks against their will whether it be inside or outside of prison and whether it is administrated by government officials, assistants or others.
